The Crucifixion Scene over the Altar, with Mary and the Disciple at the Foot of the Cross



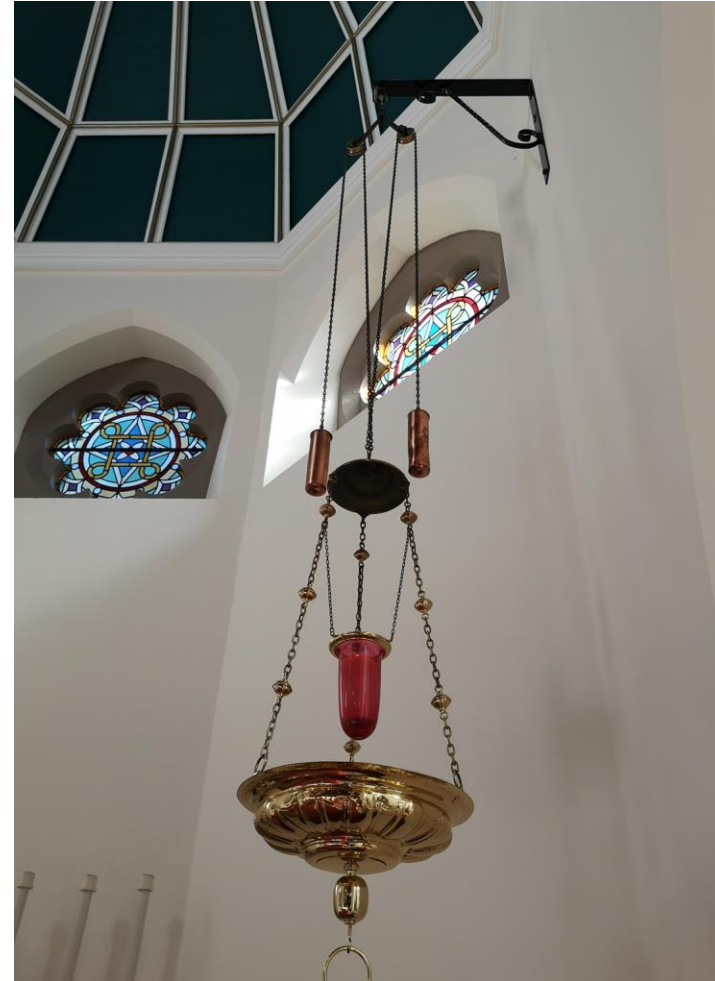
Some of the Stations of the Cross – there are 14 stations telling the story of Jesus' crucifixion

The Sanctuary Bells and Olea Sancta where the Holy Oils are kept



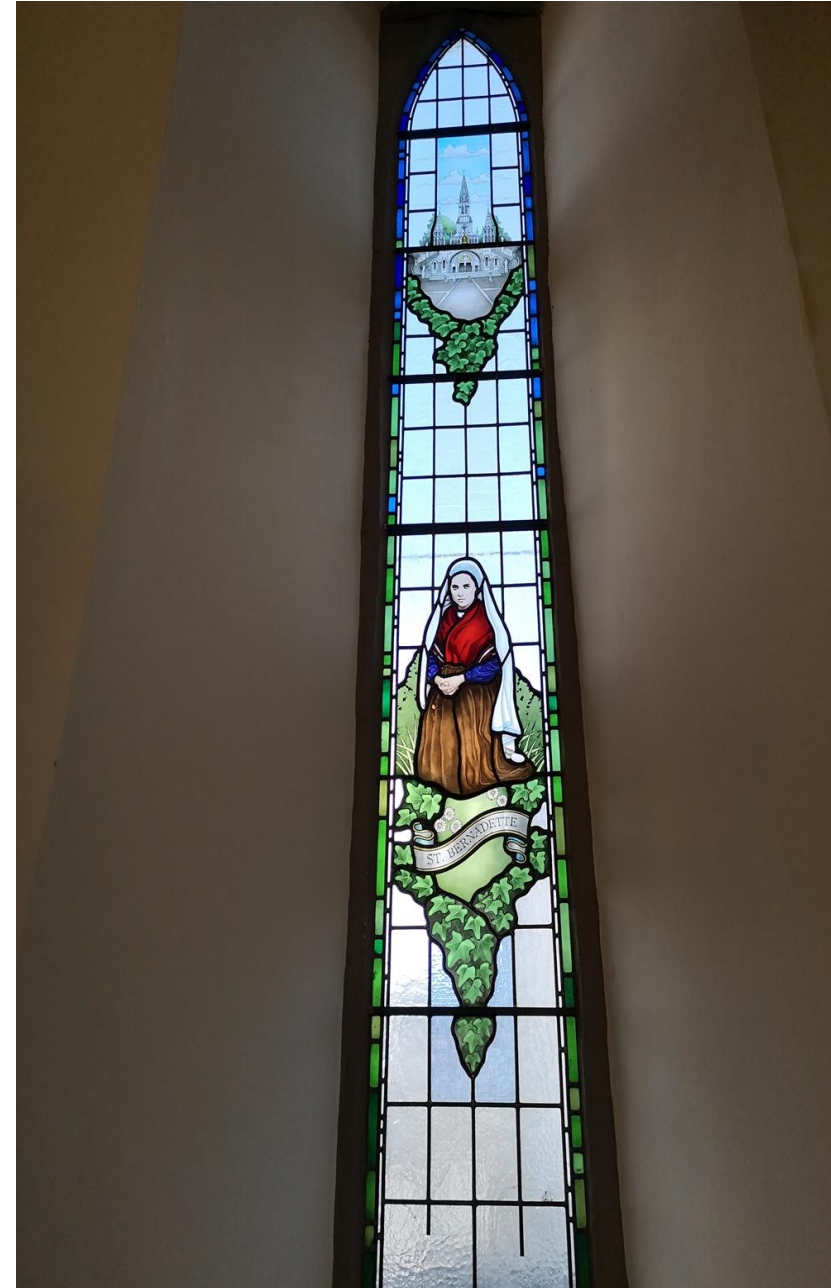

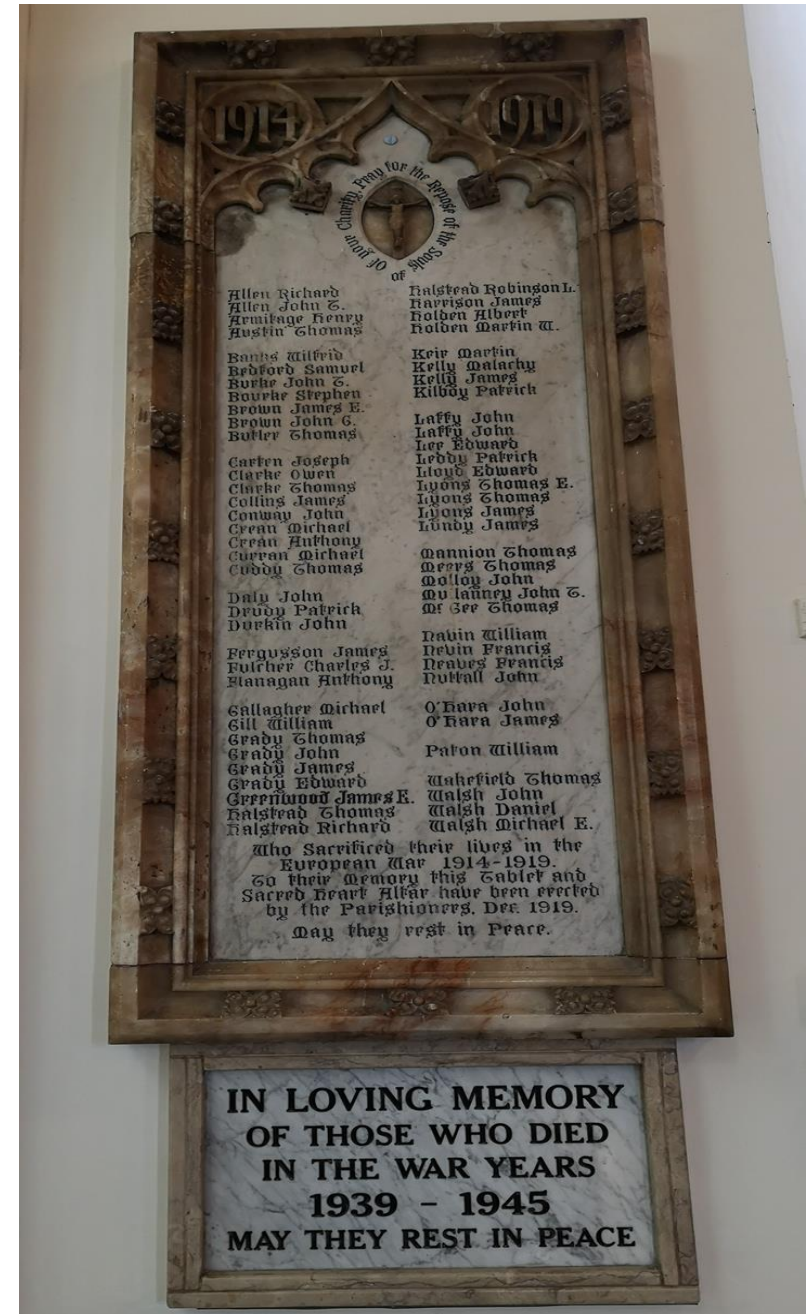

World Wars

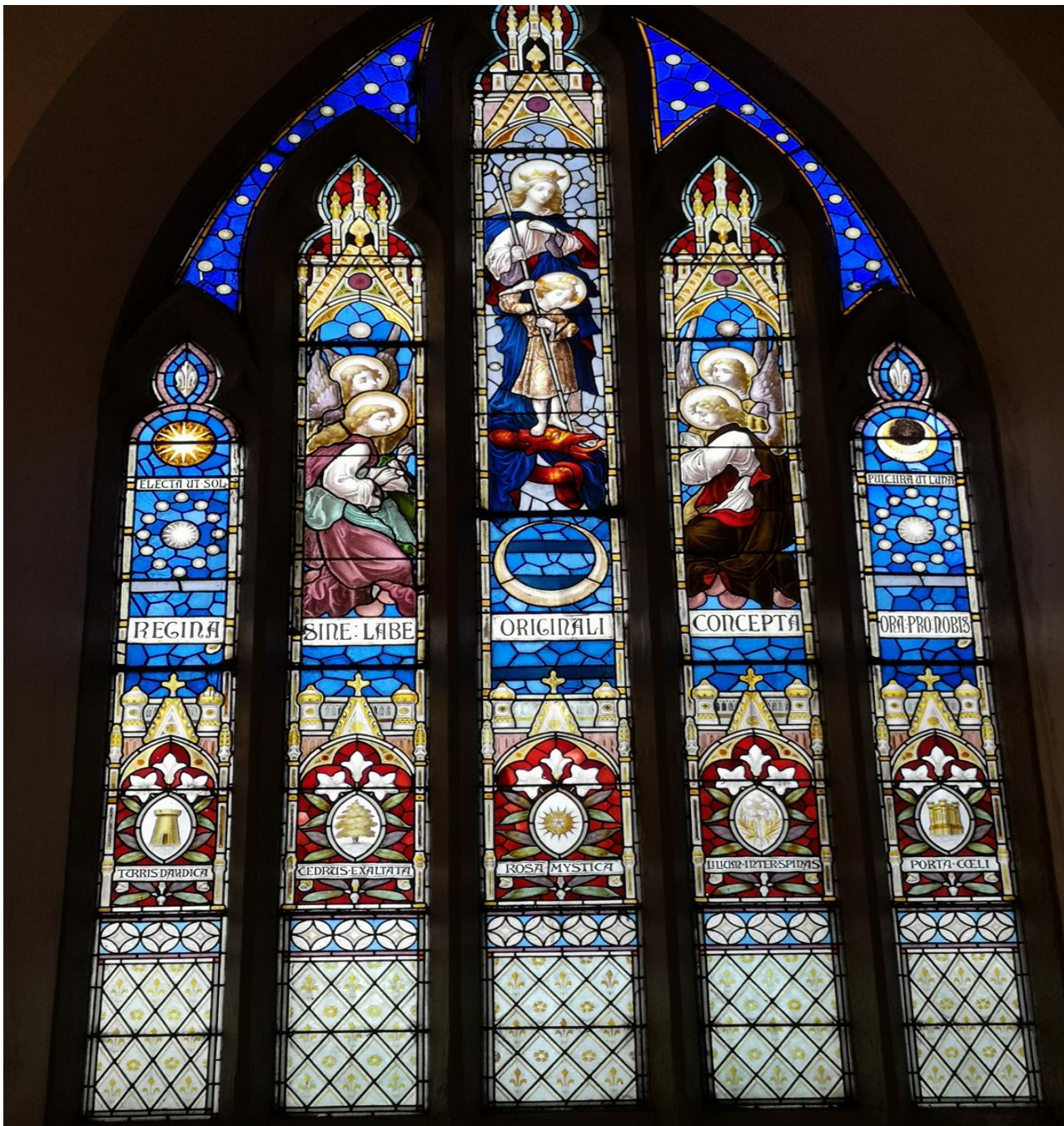


This panel used to be on the front of the old altar –
